Entry	<p>Entry is only available to residents of: Australia and must be under the age of 18 and be accompanied by parental or guardian approval to enter.</p> <p>The entrant is expected to have an established connection with West Coast Wilderness Railway, either as a previous passenger or local resident, current local West Coast resident, current or former employee of West Coast Wilderness Railway or former employee of Mt Lyell Mining and Railway Corporation.</p> <p>Immediate family of the judging panel may not enter.</p>

How to enter	<p>To enter the Competition, the entrant must submit a souvenir pin design that meets the requirements set out below. The entry will also be accompanied by an entry form and submission of up to 150 words on the entrant’s connection to WCWR or Mt Lyell Mining and Railway Corporation.</p> <p>The entrant form will include entrant’s full name, guardian’s full name, email, contact phone number and guardian’s declaration that the design is original and that the guardian grants, and has the authority to grant, exclusive permission to WCWR to use and replicate the design for the purposes of creating a physical pin and promotional content. The parent or guardian must be over the age of 18 for the submission to be valid.</p> <p>The written submission will include a written submission of up to 150 words, authored by the entrant that details the entrant’s connection with WCWR and/or Mt Lyell Mining and Railway Company and how the pin design celebrates 125 years of rail heritage between Teepookana and Regatta Point.</p> <p>The pin design entry must measure no larger than 250mm wide by 250mm high and be made available in black and white. The design must celebrate the 125 years of rail heritage between Teepookana and Regatta Point.</p> <p>The entry must be submitted via post to West Coast Wilderness Railway (Guest Experience Supervisor), PO Box 125, Queenstown, Tasmania 7467 and be accompanied by the completed entrant form and the written submission.</p>

Content Criteria	<p>Entrants are encouraged to be creative and ensure that their pin designs reflect the values and history of WCWR. The pin design entry must measure no larger than 250mm wide by 250mm high and be made available in black and white. The design must celebrate the 125 years of rail heritage between Teepookana and Regatta Point.</p> <p>The pin will be fabricated in metal and small details/fine lines may not be transferrable to the physical design. Please keep this in mind while designing your pin.</p> <p>The design should be accompanied by a written submission of up to 150-words, detailing what connection the entrant has with WCWR and/or Mt Lyell Mining and Railway Company and how the pin design celebrates 125 years of rail heritage between Teepookana and Regatta Point.</p> <p>The best design and connection response will be selected by a panel of judges.</p>

PART A - INTRODUCTION

1. Information on how to enter and Prize details form part of these terms and conditions.
